Introducing New South Carolina Society Member #302 July 10, 2017 Francis Marion Hotel, Charleston Swamp Fox Restaurant



Special Meeting of BOD in Upstate Region


SRSC Special Board Meeting in the Upstate Region at Brattonsville

GSSR Trent Trophy Six Month Activity Report January-June

On page 291 of the Sons of the **Revolution: A History, in 1967** Triennial trophy was donated to be held by State Societies for "exceptional contributions to the purposes and good of the Sons of the Revolution during the period since the preceding Triennial." It was given jointly to the State Societies with over 400 members and those under 400 members until 1997, when the criteria changed to over and under 200 members. In 2000 awards were given to large (200 or more), medium (100-199) and small (under 100 members).

The three page report forms for this period is due July 31, 2017. I have completed the report as Secretary of our state society and submitted it to GSSR. I believe it is noteworthy for all current members to be informed our content and related categories. My comparison is the six months January – June 2016 and the period of January- June 2017: The total points from 2016 were 3260 compared to a total for 2017 of 4620. This is a sizable increase reflecting our activities, though may not be in competition with other societies in the Small Category of under 100 members. So what do we attribute this

increase to?
